A Solution




- Construction Craft Laborer program
 - Trains students in several crafts
 - Carpentry (formwork)
 - Masonry, Iron Working, Electrical
 - Prepares students for entry-level construction jobs in 2 years (340 hours)
 - Better meets contractor's skill needs
 - NCCER credentialed
 - USDOL apprenticeable

Push Change


- Change our systems, policies, laws, etc.
